REGULATION

It will be played in accordance with the provisions of the Circuit Regulations, except for the points that this circular may modify:

2. DATES AND PROGRAM

Official Practices Day	Wednesday, 23 june
First day of competition	Thursday, 24 june
Second day of competition and cut	Friday, 25 june
Third day of competition:	Saturday, 26 june
Pro-Am:	Sunday, 27 june

3. PARTICIPANTS

The maximum number of participants will be 150, including members of the Association of Golf Professionals of Spain or any PGA recognized by the CPG, professionals with a valid Professional Player license from the RFEG and 25 Amateurs with a handicap 4.4 or less.

The registration of amateurs will be accepted in strict order of registration and payment of the amount thereof. Inscription: ander.martinez@pgaspain.com

4. PLAY FORMAT

The Championship will be played over 54 Stroke-Play holes, in consecutive rounds of 18 holes per day. After the first 36 holes have been played, only the first 40 classified and tied for this position will continue the tournament.

5. ENTRY RIGHTS TO THE TOURNAMENT

Professional players participating in this event who are members of the PGA of Spain, PGA recognized by the CPG and amateurs will pay € 220 for registration fees. Members of the PGA of Spain must be up to date in the payment of their fees.

Professional players participating in this event who are not members of a PGA recognized by the CPG but licensed by the RFEG, will pay € 310 for registration fees.

The Course books are included in the price. The option in meters and yards will be available.

6. PRIZES MONEY

35.000 euros + IVA

This amount is based on the registration of 90 participants. If the number of players registered in the tournament is lower, the amount of prizes will be communicated to all participants at the close of registration for the tournament.

The prizes will be distributed among the professional players who have made the cut and tied.

Reserve money: € 2,000 of the total prizes will be allocated to reserve money to cover the prizes of those professional players who pass the cut and finish below 40th place.

7. REGISTRATION

Players will be required to register before 2:00 p.m. on TUESDAY, JUNE 22.

8. INSCRIPTIONS

Registrations must be made **WRITTEN** by email to the Association of Golf Professionals of Spain, pga@pgaspain.com before 2:00 p.m., on **FRIDAY, JUNE 18, 2021.**

It is the players' responsibility to ensure that their entry has been received by the PGA by the close of the DEAD LINE.

9. PRO-AM.

The first 20 players classified in the tournament will be required to play the Pro-Am. Players must attend the prize distribution that will take place at the end of the Pro-Am and will be able to leave the club and start their return trips no later than 15:00.

Only a player may be exempted from the obligation to play the Pro-Am if the Circuit Committee considers that their causes are highly justified.

NOTE: In case that any of the players who are obliged to play the Pro-Am do not do so, unless they have express authorization from the Circuit Committee, they will automatically lose the prize money they had won in the Championship.

10. PAYMENT FORM.

All payments for this Championship will be made by the PGA of Spain.

NOTE: The first three players (and tied) must be present at the Award Ceremony of the Championship.
